A World Heritage Area

Mungo National Park was added to the World Heritage List in 1981 and preserves a major part of Australian and world wide archeology.

The park covers most of an ancient dry lake bed and preserves the longest continual records of Aboriginal life in Australia, dating at least 40,000 years of human occupation, preserves Aboriginal heritage and the landscape evidences changes in past climates.

Mungo National Park is also home to the famous "Walls of China", created by erosion overtime but originally the walls of the lake.

The Park is located approximately 110kms north-east of Wentworth and a visitor centre is located at the entrance to the park.

The roads accessing the park are mostly unsealed and extreme care should be taken accordingly.

We recommend getting there with Harry Nanya Tours who operate services to the area on a regular basis accompanied with tour guides, morning tea, lunch and all park fees included.

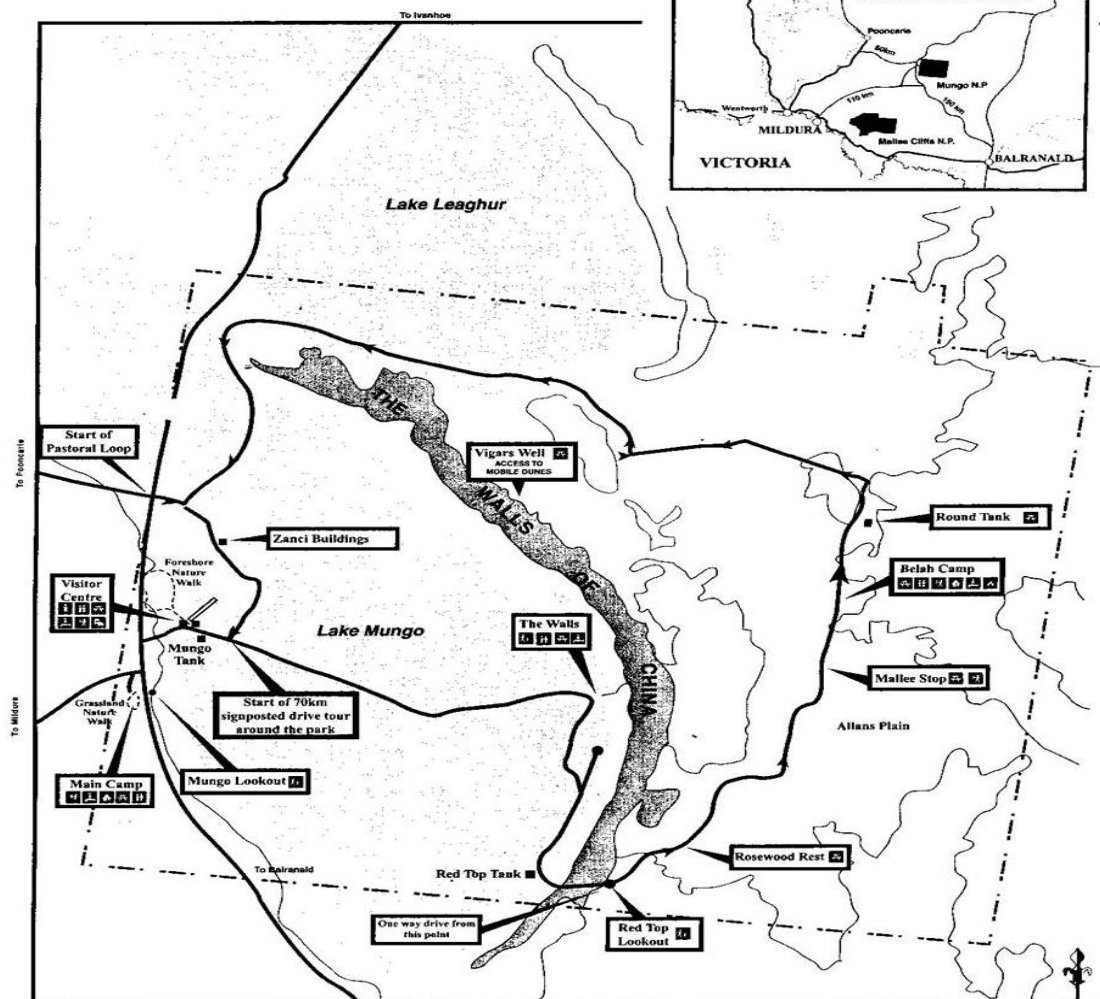
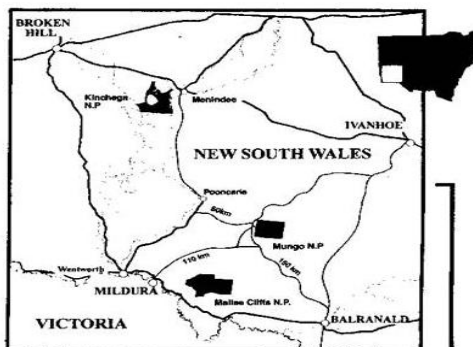


REMEMBER

When travelling in and around Mungo National Park, there is always the possibility of becoming stranded. Please follow the following safety guidelines and have a safe and enjoyable visit.

- Inform someone (family or friend) of your itinerary before setting out
- Carry extra food, FUEL, vehicle spares and EXTRA WATER.
- Outback NSW can be very hot in summer. If travelling at this time be well prepared for the conditions.
- In the event of a breakdown, remain with your vehicle.

The park lies 110 km north-east of Mildura and 150 km north-west of Balranald on the Arumpo-Ivanhoe Road. As all roads in and around the park can become impassable after rain, it is advisable to check road conditions with the NPWS Lower Darling Area Office (ph 03 5021 8900) or local tourist information centres before setting out.
